We’ll provide an introduction to information literacy, including a summary of nationally recognized information literacy competency standards for higher education. You’ll provide subject discipline expertise and knowledge of your students.

We’ll work together in small groups to embed or enhance information literacy learning outcomes in your existing assignments or evaluation tools. Together, we’ll identify the processes students should be able to “show” in order to demonstrate information literacy competency. Together, we’ll make the invisible—visible!
